- 5,600,000+ Diapers distributed since 2011
- 631,048 diapers distributed to 20 nonprofit partners to fill a critical need April - Dec 2021
- Served 3,000 under privileged children monthly
- Provided 100s of children with holiday gifts, school supplies, craft supplies
- Weekly volunteer shifts to pack and distribute boxes of food for children to bring home

NONPROFIT SUPPORT

- 3,443 hours and 171 attendees provided service through volunteer programs to our nonprofit partners
- 200+ nonprofits supported 2021-22
- 14 virtual, no cost trainings offered to nonprofits for 171 attendees
- 1000s of letters written to first responders and military personnel


