JLBR COMMUNITY ISSUES

The Junior League of Boca Raton has created several of our community's top charitable organizations. Over our 50 year history, we have invested millions of dollars, matched by millions of volunteer hours, in improving the lives of our neighbors in South Palm Beach County. We have trained thousands of women to address community needs and to take on leadership roles at every level. JLBR looks forward to the next 50 years of being a positive force for change through direct service, collaborations with other community organizations, and advocacy.

CHILD WELFARE

Child welfare is an issue that the League has focused on through various programs, projects, and collaborations with nonprofit community partners since our inception. We are tackling the problems affecting the health, safety, education and well-being of children in South Palm Beach County.

The Junior League of Boca Raton is excited to announce we have two new community projects in development.

LEARNING LIBRARIES

Learning Libraries aims to create a culture of reading outside the classroom that helps improve children's literacy development. Our objective is to inspire children to become avid readers by offering free book access through our local Learning Libraries prototypes, utilizing Junior League's voluntarism network and key community partners, like the Boca Raton Library System, Friends of the Library and other literacy organizations.

LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

At a time when youth need more support and resources than ever before, the Junior Leadership Program committee is cooking up an exciting new program for teens in the Boca Raton community. JLBR's Leadership Program will help youth gain confidence, develop leadership skills, and find their inner passion, resulting in new possibilities and brighter futures. Our curriculum combines resources from The Student Leadership Challenge, a research-based program by James M. Kouzes and Barry Posner, and Franklin Covey's The 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens. Youth will also be exposed to high-quality speakers and new experiences through partnerships with nonprofit organizations.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

By providing support and training to our nonprofit community, the League is able to empower them to improve their organizations' success and sustainability. Our highly-trained volunteers donate thousands of hours per year to fulfill the needs of our nonprofit community partners.

We advocate for our League and community issues of concern at the State level and through the development of relationships and partnerships with our community leaders and representatives. JLBR members spend hundreds of hours annually advocating for policies that directly affect our community.

JLBR also maintains and runs the Vegso Community Resource Center (VCRC) as a benefit to all area nonprofits. This building is uniting our community by offering resources and low-cost rental facilities.

The Grant Library at the VCRC is part of the Funding Information Network of the Foundation Center, Inc. and

offers core materials and other resources which are extremely useful to nonprofit organizations seeking funding information and about nonprofit management. Vegso 2007. the Community Resource Center received the Vision Award from the Association of Junior Leagues International. The JLBR offers this resource to all area nonprofits free charge.
